RESPIRATORY SYNCYTIAL VIRUS

RSV IS A SEASONAL RESPIRATORY VIRUS that can be dangerous for some babies and young children.

RSV is the **leading cause of hospitalization** for babies under age 1.



Good hygiene & cleaning practices can help prevent RSV.



Sanitize surfaces frequently



Wash hands often



Cover coughs and sneezes



Wash toys regularly

It's important to protect your baby from unnecessary risks during RSV season.



Avoid taking your baby into **large crowds**



Don't smoke around your baby



Avoid contact with **sick people**
