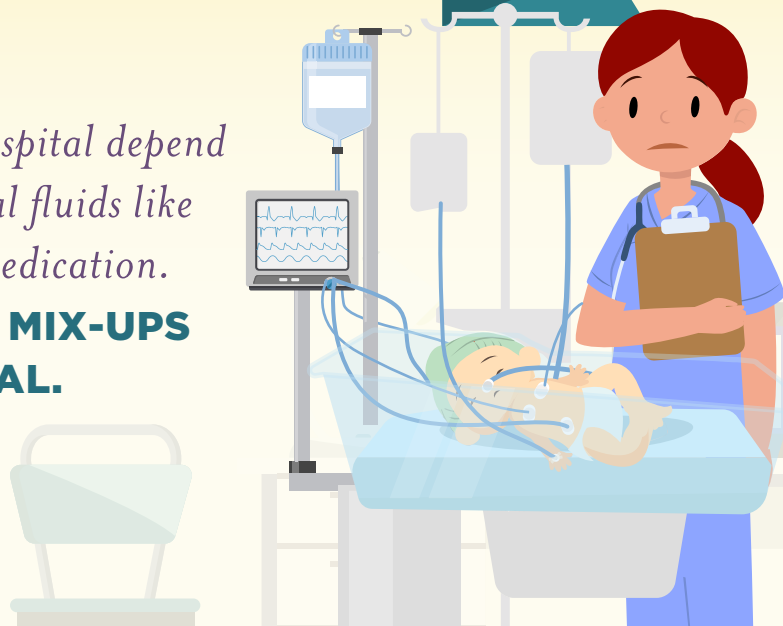


HOSPITAL TUBING AND

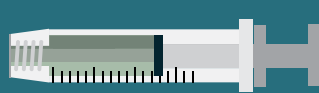
INFANT SAFETY

Babies in the hospital depend on tubes for vital fluids like nutrition and medication.

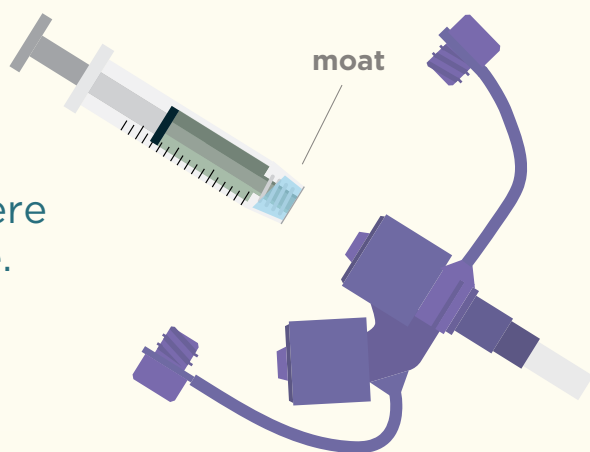
BUT TUBING MIX-UPS CAN BE FATAL.



A new tubing design called ENFit[®] can prevent mix-ups...but poses problems of its own.



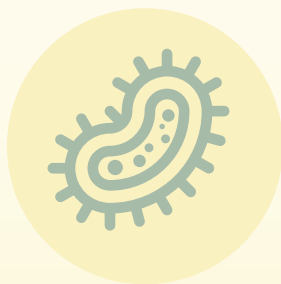
The ENFit[®] syringe features a **moat** where extra liquid can hide.



This can expose infants to the risk of:



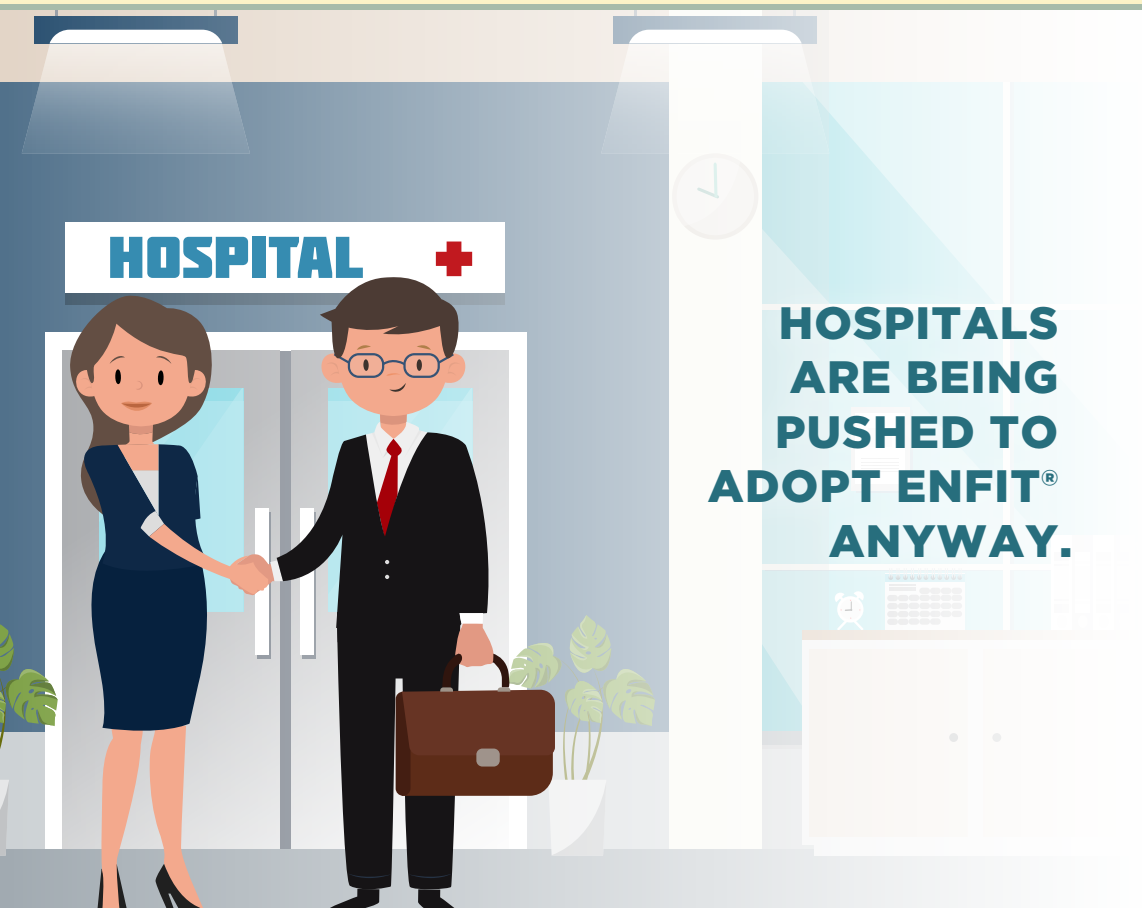
Medication overdose
