Approved for:	Pregnant women for the protection of infants	All infants born during or entering their first RSV season AND Children up to 24 months of age who remain at risk of severe RSV disease through their second RSV season	All infants born during or entering their first RSV season
Administered:	During 32 weeks through 36 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy at a health care provider's office or pharmacy	In the hospital after birth before discharge OR In a health care provider's office	In the hospital after birth before discharge OR In a health care provider's office
How supplied:	3-component kit that requires reconstitution	Pre-filled syringe: 50 mg and 100 mg	Pre-filled syringe: 105 mg regardless of the infant's weight
